3) Pedialyte, ice pops, juice

4) Luke warm baths (NOT cold; cold induces shivering which may RAISE your child's temperature)

5) Follow up with your child's doctor within 1-2 days. Call TODAY to make an appointment and tell them your child was seen in the ER and needs to be seen for follow up

6) Return to the ER if your child is unable to tolerate fluids, has difficulty breathing or worsening condition.
